



## Backroads

Backroads, an internationally recognized active travel company, retained Trachtenberg Architects to create its headquarters on a site in West Berkeley. The site consisted of four existing warehouse buildings dominated by a parking lot.

The project adapts and unifies the existing building fabric to provide facilities for the company including offices, conference rooms, cafe, training and parking. A fifth, building, the only entirely new structure, provides parking and additional office space. The building complex of 13,000 square feet is organized around a lush courtyard garden that provides private space for company meetings, parties and casual enjoyment.
